

## Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

This is an agreement between Magna Carta College, Oxford, UK, University of Wales, hereinafter called MCC (First Party)

and

Harishchandra Ramkali Group of Institutions, Ghaziabad consisting of H.R. Institute of Technology; H.R. Institute of Pharmacy; H.R. Institute of Hotel Management; H.R. Institute of Professional Management; H.R. Institute of Science & Technology; H.R. Institute of Engineering & Technology and Delhi Public school, hereinafter called HRGI, Ghaziabad, India (Second Party)

### **I. Purpose and scope**

The purpose of this MOU is to clearly identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to agreed activities. In particular this MOU is intended to:

- establish mutually beneficial cooperation in the *admission/* recruitment of Indian students at different courses of MCC;
- to develop the market in the executive education segment;
- in addition there is interest to develop online MBA and Masters Programmes and blended learning programmes; and,
- the MOU is also intended to identify the areas of mutual interest for co-operation between the two parties..

### **II. Background**

MCC is a UK based Private College in higher education in both face to face and distance learning segments. Please see [www.magnacartacollege.org](http://www.magnacartacollege.org)

and

HRGI is an India based private group of colleges duly recognised by Ministry of HRD, Government of India and affiliated to Mahamaya Technical University, Noida offering face to face education. One of it's Institute is affiliated to CCS University, Meerut.

### **III. MCC responsibilities under this MOU**

MCC will act as a foreign collaborative partner with HRGI for following mutual points of agreement :

- Admission to Top –up MBA from MCC as dual Degree Programme for existing ***MBA & PGDM students of HRGI;***
- Full time MBA from MCC for all ***undergraduate programmes running at HRGI, which includes B.Pharma, BBA, BCA, B.Com, BJMC, BHMCT and B.Tech;***
- Mutual exchange of internship students;
- ***Admission***/Recruitment of HRGI MBA/ PGDM students for summer course at MCC;
- ***Admission***/Recruitment of HRGI management students for Blended learning Programme at MCC online;
- Development of joint Masters Degree as stage 2 i.e., after initial success of the above mentioned conditions of MOU to be known as stage 1;
- Faculty exchange between MCC and ***HRGI;***
- ***Admission***/Recruitment of HRGI students/ faculty for Ph.D. at Gloucestershire University, UK through MCC; and,
- ***Admission***/Recruitment for B.A Top up ; M.A. Marketing; MBA ( Health Care Management); MBA ( International Management); and MBA (Business Law);
- MCC will develop a programme to create an awareness and to attract students for their various courses as agreed upon, which includes motivational lectures of their eminent faculty at HRGI Campus for prospective candidates as and when required at least twice a year

#### **IV. HRGI Responsibilities under this MOU**

HRGI will develop programmes to admit/recruit students for activities outlined above and MCC will ensure with Universities of Wales and Gloucestershire that appropriate mapping of course and credits can be given for MBA and will enable its programmes to absorb the students from HRGI. HRGI faculty/officials will visit MCC to ensure faithful implementation of the MOU as and when required at least twice a year.

#### **V. It is mutually understood between the parties that**

Modification of the MOU should be made only when both the parties agreed

#### **VI. Funding:**

This MOU does not include reimbursement of cost between the two parties.

#### **VII. Force Measure**

- i) However, this MOU will stand annulled if the AICTE or any Govt. Authority/University brings any irregularity to notice.

ii) Other terms and conditions regarding share of fees and of exclusive partnership will be signed separately.

iii) This MOU is executed at Ghaziabad on 7<sup>th</sup> of May 2012 is also subject to Ghaziabad, India Jurisdiction.

**VIII. Effective dates and Signatures:**

This MOU shall be effective upon the signature of MCC and HRGI authorised officials. It shall be in force from 7<sup>th</sup> of May 2012.
